

The Programme and Organizing Committees invite you to take part in the XIX Russian Conference on charged particle accelerators. The biennial conference brings together scientists working on all aspects of accelerator physics and their application. RUPAC'04 is expected to attract about 250 scientists and engineers from accelerator communities all over the world.

GOAL OF THE CONFERENCE

The Conference provides a forum for exchange of new information and discussion in the area of acceleration science and engineering, particle beam physics, new accelerator designs, modernization of existing facilities, accelerator use for scientific purposes and applications.

LOCATION

The Joint Institute for Nuclear Research (JINR) will host RUPAC'2004. JINR is an international institute (<u>http://www.jinr.ru</u>/) situated in a small picturesque town of Dubna <u>http://www.dubna.ru/</u>). Dubna is about 130 km north of Moscow on the bank of the Great Russian River Volga, 100 km from international airport Sheremetyevo.

DATES

October 4-8, 2004. The Conference will start on Monday, October 4 at 15.00.

- 6. Magnetic systems, power supply and vacuum systems for accelerators.
- 7. Superconducting accelerators and technology of cryogenics.
- 8. Accelerating structures and powerful electronics.
- 9. Control and diagnostic systems.
- 10. Ion sources, electron guns.
- 11. Accelerators for medical and industrial purposes.
- 12. Radiation problems in accelerators.
- 13. Injectors.

PRESENTATIONS

The Conference program will consist of review reports (30 min), oral presentations (20 min) and poster reports (poster size 140 x 70 cm). A tentative program including the titles of the sessions and all registered papers can be found on the RUPAC'04 web site.

Papers are solicited in all of listed topics. The conference languages are Russian and English. All the reports will be supported with a synchronic translation. You should send your abstract before 1 August, 2004 if you want your report to be included into the Conference Program. All the authors will be informed on decision of the Programme Committee concerning the form of the presentation after August 1, 2004. The abstracts being sent after August 1, 2004 will be

considered by the Organizing and Programme Committee separately to solve the question about the including this report in the Conference program.

CONFERENCE VENUE

The Conference will be held in the Conference Hall of the Laboratory of Information Technologies, JINR. A poster session will be held in the same building.

CONFERENCE FEE

The conference fee for the participants is 600 Euro before 1 August 2004 and 700 Euro later.

It will cover transportation from the airport or railway station and back, hotel accommodation (6 nights), coffee/tea breaks, Welcome Party, Conference Proceedings, Conference Dinner and social program. The fee for the accompanying persons is 400 Euro before 1 August 2004 and 450 Euro later.

ACCOMMODATION

Participants will be accommodated in a hotel "Dubna" in single and double rooms. This hotel is about 10 minutes walk from the conference venue. The Organizing Committee will arrange accommodation for the participants.

The Conference participants will receive copies of the Book of Abstracts on CD-disks. A hard copy of the proceedings can be obtained for extra pay.

The reports as a hard copy and an electronic version on a diskette 3,5" in Russian or English should be submitted to the Organizing Committee on the first day of the Conference.
